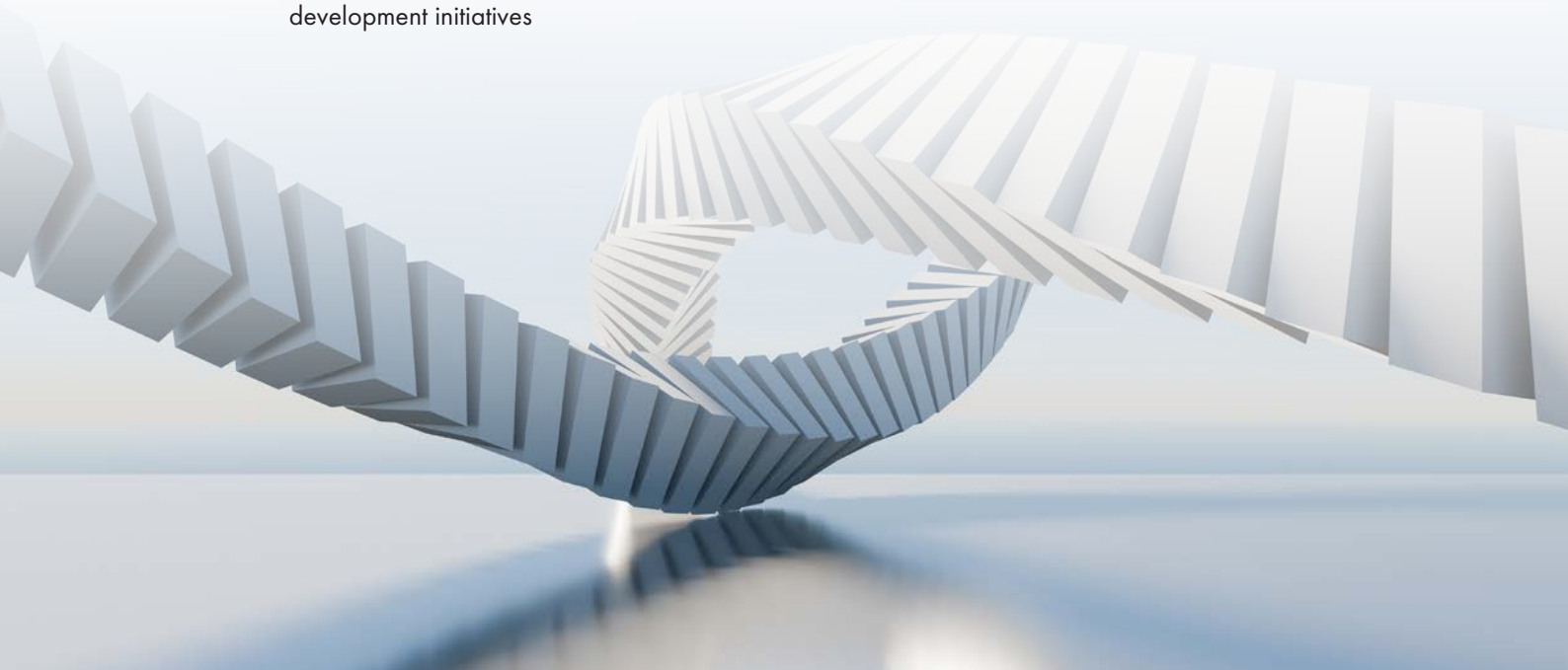

Advocacy

SIAA represents the interests of members through public policy submissions, government and stakeholder meetings, and media engagement.

We regularly meet with government, regulators and industry leaders to advocate on key priorities, including:

- Reform of adviser education standards
- Appropriate wholesale investor thresholds
- ASX's CHES replacement project
- Industry collaboration to combat fraud and scams
- The cost and sustainability of the Compensation Scheme of Last Resort
- Regulatory settings that support strong and accessible capital markets



Education

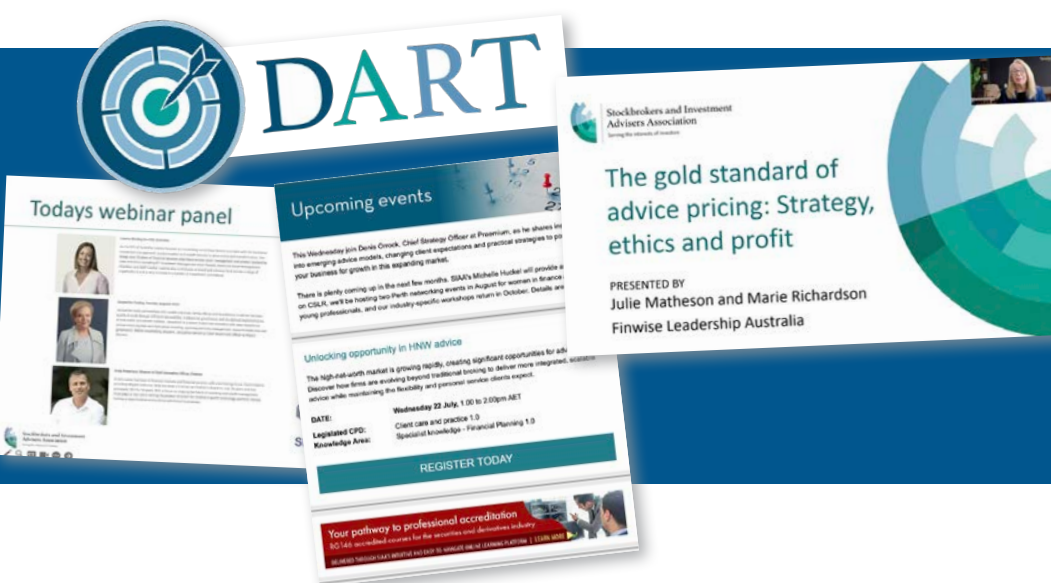
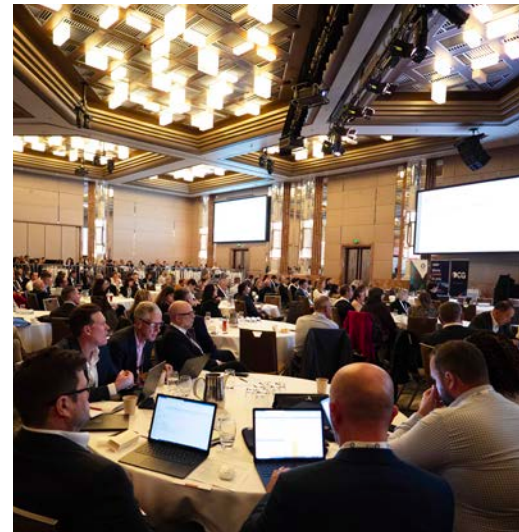
SIAA provides practical education and professional development to support people across all stages of their careers.

COMMITTEES

Compliance

Discusses compliance and legal issues of importance for our members including ASX and Cboe market issues, ASIC Market Integrity Rules and ASIC consultations, Treasury consultations, CSLR, DBFO, Education standards, Share Sale Fraud, AFCA and AML.

Derivatives

Represents the broad spectrum of the derivatives market including ASX, ASIC, market makers and clearers. The committee receives updates from both ASX and ASIC and discuss issues important to the derivatives industry.

Profession

Supports the recognition of stockbroking and investment advisory as a profession by developing appropriate professional, ethical and education policies for adoption by the Board.

Investment Advisers

Advises SIAA on regulatory, policy and professional matters affecting stockbroking and investment advice, including professional standards, industry guidance, regulatory priorities and initiatives that strengthen investor protection and market integrity.

Ops and Tech

Discusses issues in operations and technology relevant to the industry and the impact of those changes on industry participants. It provides valuable feedback on issues including CHES replacement and market upgrades.

Diversity Equity and Inclusion

Focuses on helping firms improve diversity, equity and inclusion across stockbroking, investment advice and wealth management, with an initial focus on gender balance and practical initiatives that support inclusive workplace cultures.

WORKING GROUPS

DTR

Designated Trading Representatives from across the industry meet to discuss regulatory issues, including Markets Disciplinary Panel fines, and DTR education.

Equity Capital Market

Provides feedback to consultations on capital markets issues. This group covers topics such as the ASIC Discussion paper on public and private markets and the proposed listing rule changes arising from the James Hardie matter.

Share Sale Fraud

Chaired by the ASX, a key function of the working group is to enhance knowledge, information sharing and collaboration to help combat fraudulent share sale activity. SIAA provides secretariat support to this group.

Young Professional

Helps shape activities and initiatives for emerging professionals and provides a stronger voice for the next generation of the industry.
